Philippe Guérineau has been serving as DOMO's Chief Commercial Officer Europe & Europe Export since 1 September 2021. During this time, he has led the strategic development and execution of DOMO's commercial strategy which encompasses the company's application centers, polymers and intermediates, as well as the performance fibers businesses.

Philippe joined DOMO Chemicals in December 2015, his initial role responsible for the Trading and Distribution business unit. He was promoted to Vice President of the DOMO Polymers and Intermediates business unit, and on 1 February 2020 following the acquisition of the European Solvay Performance Polyamides business, Philippe supervised the two upstream value chains of Polyamide 6 and Polyamide 66. This has helped the company to achieve significant growth and develop a strong leadership position in a competitive market.

During the post-merger integration, Philippe was leading the "Improve DOMO" program, a holistic initiative to drive the company's transformation in three horizons: value realization, capability uplift, and change management.

With more than 25 years' experience within the polymer and chemical industry, advising international companies in Europe and emerging economies, Philippe has led global strategic developments in a variety of situations and organizations.
